

The Arctic

The Arctic



The Arctic is the most northern habitat on Earth, surrounding the north pole and including the northern edges of Europe, Asia, North America and Greenland. The Arctic is made up mostly of frozen ocean. The Arctic land is called the *tundra* – a rolling plain with no trees. The ground is frozen almost all year with *permafrost*. In summer, the melted snow above the permafrost makes for a boggy landscape. Some Arctic animals include the caribou, Arctic fox, harp seal, killer whale, walrus, snowshoe hare, musk ox, and puffin.
